Dear Parents,

We would like to thank you for entrusting us with your children at our **ELITE SPORTING CLUB LARNAKA SUMMER SCHOOL**, now in its 13th consecutive year at the premises of **PASCAL ENGLISH SCHOOL in LARNAKA**. Our main concern, as always, is the safety of your children. We also want them to enjoy themselves, have a great time, play, and train in a safe and happy environment through our various activities and sports programs. The organizers, qualified instructors, team leaders, and assistants work hard every day to ensure that your child is safe and having fun, something we successfully achieve every year.

The SUMMER SCHOOL at ELITE SPORTING CLUB LARNAKA will operate for 7 consecutive weeks, from Tuesday, 22 June 2026, until Friday, 7 August 2026, from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

INFORMATION & RULES (FOR SAFETY REASONS)

1. Only children and ELITE SPORTING CLUB LARNAKA personnel are permitted to enter the premises. Parents are not allowed inside due to safety measures.
2. **Entry to the SUMMER SCHOOL is through the first entrance on the main road (see attached map).**
3. Upon arrival, children will be met by their Group Leaders and escorted to their designated groups. The same procedure applies at departure time.
4. **Children must arrive between 7:30-8:00 a.m. and depart between 2:30-3:00 p.m.** Arrivals and departures outside these times are not permitted except in emergencies, as gates will remain locked in accordance with safety guidelines. If someone else will be collecting your child, please inform us in advance.
5. **Food will be available at the school canteen (see attached canteen menu/pre-order form). Younger children may pre-order and pre-pay daily or weekly. Older children may purchase or pre-order food independently.**
6. If food is brought from home, Group Leaders and assistants will help younger children during breaks. All food must be placed in a sealed container clearly labeled with the child's name.
7. Children must remain with their groups at all times and should ask their instructors, teachers, or team leaders for assistance when needed.
8. Toilet breaks should be taken during scheduled break times unless necessary.
9. Children should bring enough water for the day. Additional water can be purchased from the canteen (€0.50). For safety reasons, refilling bottles from taps is not permitted.

10. **On swimming days, children must bring swimming goggles, a swimming cap, a towel, flip-flops, and a dry T-shirt. Swim belts will be used for all children under 10 years old and for older children who are not confident swimmers. If swimming is scheduled during the first morning period, please send your child ready for the lesson.**
11. Due to limited spaces, enrollment is weekly only. Daily attendance options are not available. If a child attends only part of the week, the full weekly fee still applies and cannot be transferred to another week.
12. For organizational purposes, please notify us by Thursday of each week if your child will be attending the following week. Payment of €80 must be made at the same time. A place cannot be guaranteed without notification and payment.
13. Please keep your payment receipt and have it signed each time a payment is made to avoid any misunderstandings. If you make your payment online, please request a payment card from the organizers. The card will be placed in your child's backpack on their first day of attendance.
14. Unfortunately, refunds cannot be provided for cancellations.
15. The minimum participation period is two weeks per child.
16. In addition to qualified instructors, teachers, trainers, and coaches, each group will have one or two Team Leaders/Assistants available throughout the day.
17. Children may be photographed or filmed for promotional purposes, including social media and website publications. If you do not wish your child to appear, please inform us immediately.
18. Parents are responsible for arranging their own accident/emergency insurance coverage for their child. The summer school accepts no liability for such incidents.
19. Children or parents who fail to comply with these rules may receive a warning. Continued misconduct may result in exclusion from the summer school without a refund.
20. To ensure the smooth running of activities, mobile phones and other electronic devices are not permitted. The organizers are not responsible for any loss or damage. Please avoid bringing valuable items.
21. Please inform us of any medical conditions, allergies, or other relevant issues affecting your child.
22. Our first priority is the health and safety of every child, while also ensuring that they enjoy themselves and learn through the various activities and sports we provide.

We would also like to inform you that afternoon activities for September 2026-June 2027 will begin on the **1st of September**. Information leaflets and registration forms are available for the following activities: **Football, Swimming, Chess, Tennis, Rhythmic Gymnastics, Ballet, Arts & Creations, Zumba Kids, and Dance (Latin, Modern, Hip Hop, and Contemporary).**
